- It does not replace other existing Faith Formation groups
- RCIA: 7 people are participating from the cluster parishes.

• Parish Life Commission

- o Has not met since December Pastoral Council meeting.
- o Hospitality Weekend is next weekend.

Social Justice Commission

- There is a great deal of interest in increasing the awareness and sense of connectivity with our sister parish St. Joan of Arc.
- The commission requests input on how best to achieve this and puts forward interest in working with the school to create connections with school aged children.
- Thoughts from the council include:
 - Fr. Mike suggests getting in contact with the St. Joan of Arc priest before moving forward with any ideas.
 - Email Trevor this idea concerning our sister parish so he can present it to the teachers.
 - Could St. Joan of Arc parishioners be sponsored to come here? –
 Historically this has happened
 - There is strong desire to continue supporting the St. Joan of Arc partnership financially

• It was also proposed that an exploratory group of OLA parishioners could visit St. Joan of Arc again to establish additional personal connections and evaluate the current needs of St. Joan of Arc.

• Stewardship Commission

- o Currently, this commission has the following main roles:
 - Time and Talent Survey
 - Work with finance on Stewardship Weekend
 - Welcoming Packet
- o This commission has a small membership—possibly need to increase the membership of this committee or merge with another one
- o Discussion was held on the full role that this commission should take on/consider Perhaps education on the purpose of this commission is required. (As stated in council discussion, the role of this commission is not just "asking for money.")
- o Will use Time and Talent survey to invite additional members
- o Personal invitations will be more effective in conjunction with a bulletin blurb
- o Will invite Welcoming group members to become members of commission
- o Will contact Jeanne for last year's Time and Talent survey

• Finance Council

- o 145 families now pay online & 35 families use bill pay (ACH)
- o Budgeting process is underway
- o 80% of this year's Offertory budget is pledged
- o Church Bylaws are completed
- o 395 pledges \$625,000 pledged is down a bit from last year, but last year's pledged money was collected at 90% rate which is excellent
- o 80% of this year's budget is pledged
- o Pledge cards are still being accepted
- o School budget will be completed at February meeting
- o Church budget will be completed at March meeting
- o Technology Committee has reported
 - It is on schedule for updating campus security, etc. by March
 - The school Self-study continues
 - There will be a small cost for room and board for the visiting Accreditation Team (group that assists with the self-study) while it is on campus for 3 days
 - The cost for the Accreditation Team that does this is included in the budget
 - There is a technology survey on the church website (information in bulletin) please fill out
